

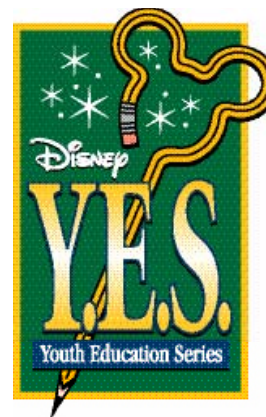

Disney Y.E.S. Program Terms and Conditions: Groups wishing to participate in a Disney Y.E.S. program must complete and submit this Program Request Form via Fax to 407-566-7688. This form should be submitted as soon as program choices are made and at least six weeks in advance. This form may, however, be submitted up to 12 months in advance. Upon the group's acceptance into any Disney Y.E.S. program experience, the Group Leader will receive written confirmation of the scheduled program(s), date(s) and time(s). To finalize your participation in Y.E.S. program(s), the Group must complete and submit a Ticket Order form prior to the Group Main Arrival Date.

- All programs subject to availability and are three hours in length unless otherwise noted. Program content, times and locations are subject to change due to inclement weather, attraction availability, or group dynamics. A minimum of 10 students is required for program participation, and each participant must meet stated grade level requirements and all posted Disney safety guidelines. Children under 11 years of age are not permitted backstage at Disney's Animal Kingdom Theme Park.
- Prerequisite: Must attend La Nouba™ show prior to Showbiz Magic Y.E.S. Program.
- To maintain the high-quality and age-appropriate Disney Y.E.S. learning experience, no more than one adult for every five participating students may attend Disney Y.E.S. programs.
- Theme Park admission is required for each program participant to be admitted into the designated Theme Park location for the program.

- Only one program is included in each Disney Y.E.S. Package. Additional programs are available at a cost of \$26.00 per person.
- Payment in advance is not required. Confirmed groups may make payment and pick up their pre-arranged Disney Y.E.S. Packages and options at the time of arrival.
- Groups must arrange their own transportation to and from ALL program and options. Walt Disney World Transportation is not available.
